## Kwassui Women's University Exchange International Student Application Guide

Kwassui has established Programs of six months and one year for Exchange International Students. These students take Japanese language classes and have the possibility of taking classes in our regular departments. In addition to improving their Japanese skills, students learn about Japanese culture.

## **Semester Dates**

Spring: April 1 to mid-August

Fall: September 25 to mid-March

#### Eligibility to apply

- 1. Applicants who have foreign nationality
- 2. Applicants who are female students only
- 3. Applicants who have completed 12 years of regular school education in countries other than Japan
- 4. Applicants who have Japanese and/or English ability enough for study at our university
- 5. Applicants who have the residence qualification of "University Student visa" by "Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Law" or can acquire the residence qualification of "University Student visa"

### Application Deadline

For Spring entry: November 30 of the previous year

For Fall entry: June 30

## Notification Date of results

For Spring: End of November

For Fall: 10th of July

#### Application Documents

This information applies to students entering as Exchange International Students

1. Completed Application Form (official Kwassui form with photograph attached). The applicant should fill in the application forms herself in Japanese or English. State reasons for applying to Kwassui Women's University (To be written by the

- applicant in Japanese, 400 characters, or English.)
- Certification of enrollment and Transcript of academic record
  \*If the original is in the student's mother tongue, a Japanese or English translation should be sent along with the original.)
- 3. Health certificate (official Kwassui form to have been completed by a doctor within the past three months)
- 4. Letter of recommendation from the principal, president, dean or head of department of the most recently attended academic institution (official Kwassui form)
- 5. Statement of plan for financial support (statement of how you plan to pay Kwassui fees and living expenses), if required
- 6. Certification of employment of student's financial supporter, if required
- 7. Statement of income of student's financial supporter, if required
- 8. Certification of bank balance (showing ability to cover school fees, accommodation and living fees), if required
- 9. Copy of passport (picture page)
- 10. Three photographs (3cm×4cm) with student's name on the back

#### Points to note

- 1. The applicant should fill out the application forms herself in Japanese or English.
- 2. The name on the application form must match the name on the applicant's passport.
- 3. Health certificate must have been completed by a doctor within the past three months.
- 4. The completed application documents and fees cannot be returned under any circumstances.
- 5. Once an application has been received, there can be no change in the department being applied to.

Facilities: desk, chair, bookshelf, desk lamp, intercom, bed, closet (wardrobe), locker for each student, and a refrigerator, an air-conditioning/heating unit, laundry airing stands, Internet wireless connection

Public facilities: piano practice rooms, computer rooms, sewing and ironing room, Library, health room, dining room, meeting room, Tatami(Japanese style) room, lounge, study room, laundry facilities, shower, Japanese style bath, air-conditioning

Pay facilities: Electric usage fee for own room, cooker, dryer, shower Students bring blanket, sheet, futon and pillow

Students can only move out of the dormitory at the end of the academic year, unless special permission is given by the International Student Exchange Center.
